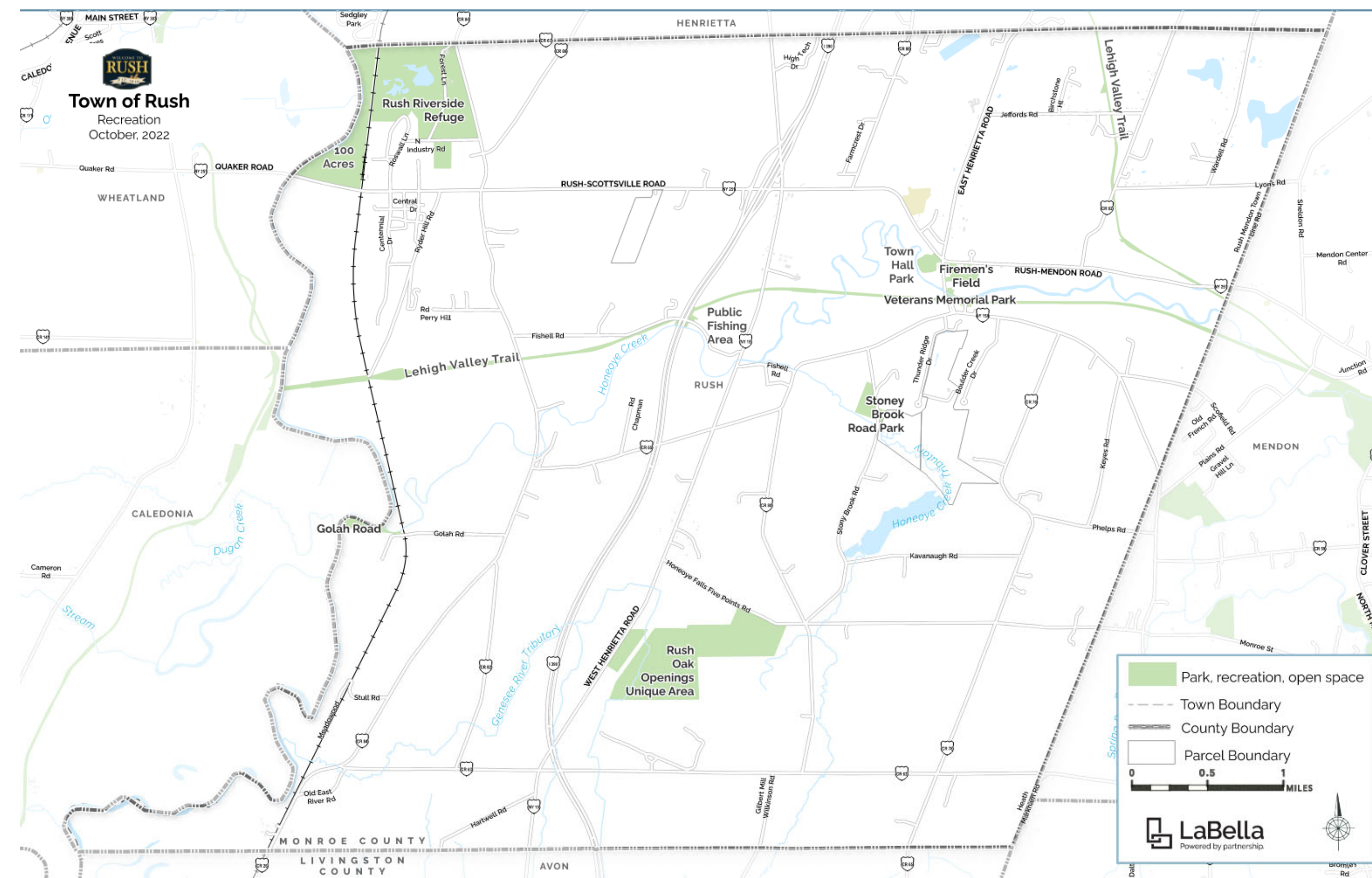

## Comprehensive Plan Goals and Strategies

**Goal:** *Maintain and improve park and recreational facilities to benefit all Town residents.*



### Strategies:

1. Continue to maintain and improve existing Town parks and recreation facilities.
2. Develop additional sites for kayak / canoe launching.
3. Continue to develop Rush Riverside Refuge and the Hundred Acres for recreational and conservation use.
4. Expand trail system and improve access to the Lehigh Valley trail.
5. Improve signage at Town parks

### Local Waterfront Revitalization Plan (LWRP)
