

Comprehensive Plan Goals and Strategies


Protect water quality and natural ecosystems. Goals: Reduce flood risk and mitigate potential flood damage. Maintain sensitive ecological communities and wildlife habitat



Strategies:

- Limit vegetation removal within stream corridors ("riparian buffers").
- Maintain drainage infrastructure to minimize risks from flooding. 2.
- Provide information to landowners about responsible land 3. stewardship and best management practices.
